(Continued From Page One) of the Japanese General news agency. Other broadcasts reported three powerful American convoys operating northward to join the assault against undisciplined forces west of Mindoro. 150 transports south of Mindoro and 25 warships further south, all headed in the general direction of Manila.

Claim Sinkings

An imperial communication claimed that since last Wednesday Japanese have sunk seven first line warships and 18 transports and damaged nine other vessels in the various Leyte gulf waters. Japanese troops guarding Leyte gulf waters could see the long line of American warships were described as 'awaiting the enemy with resolute determination. Therefore it is anticipated that a great enemy annihilation battle will be unrolled' as soon as amphibious troops strike.

GENERAL MACARTHUR'S HEADQUARTERS, Philippines, Jan. 8 (AP) — American troops were within 90 miles of Manila today but army and navy command reported no support to Japanese claims the Yanks were actually preparing any immediate invasion of Luzon island.

Gen. Douglas MacArthur's forces have moved 15 miles up the coast of Mindoro island to capture Palanan town. Palanan is 30 miles from Luzon. Manila is less than 80 miles further north.

Pounding Continues

The communique said air pounding of enemy installations on Luzon was continuing. Navy carrier planes also attacked Luzon. Fleet Adm. Chester W. Nimitz announced at Pacific fleet headquarters, Pearl Harbor, that the attack was made Saturday (Philippine time).
