OLYMPIA, Feb. 2 (#)-Gov. Mon C. Wallgren's liquor liber-alization bill made its formal bow in the state house of repre-sentatives yesterday and bump-ed into predictions that (1) it will not get out of the house liquor committee-to which it was referred — without amend-ments, and (2) it will emerge intact. Rep. Armstrong (D-King),

ments, and (2) it will emerge intact. Rep. Armstrong (D-King), chairman of the committee, foresaw the likelihood of amendments and Rep. O'Brien, also a King county d'emocrat, said he was convinced the 15-man committee included enough supporters of the measure to get it through unscathed. Armstrong criticized the measure as too moderate and said he believed the governor would consent to changes. In the upper house, Sen. Zednick (R-King) made a flat prediction the bill would be defeated in the bill would be defeated in the house and never reach the senate floor.
