Wacs Welcome Returning Soldiers on Gripsholm

JERSEY CITY, N. J., Feb. 21 (AP)—Joyously welcomed by uniformed Wacs—the girls they left behind them — 463 sick and wounded American soldiers came back from German prison camps today on the exchange ship Gripsholm.

A Wac-filled army boat, its loudspeaker blaring the strains of "Don't Fence Me In," met the sleek 18,000-ton Swedish motorship at quarantine, and a Wac band at the pier serenaded the men who were among the Gripsholm's 1209 passengers.

The ship docked shortly after 1 p. m. (EWT). Fifty-five ambulances were gathered at the Hudson river pier to remove the servicemen to the army's Halloran General hospital on Staten island.

Passengers running from port to starboard to wave at the circling army boat caused the Gripsholm to list as much as 10 degrees, said Lt. Comdr. James Kahn, navy public relations officer who went aboard at quarantine.
