The western front: Americans near heart of Cologne, allies controlled virtually all Rhine west bank northward to point south of Wesel; third army moved ahead under security blackout; seventh army at outskirts of Saarbruecken, Saarland capital.

The Russian front: Russians threatened to outflank and seize Stettin, Berlin's Baltic port, for enveloping move on capital from north; other Russians cut deeper into coastal strip of Pomerania.

The Italian front: Americans took village 13 miles southwest of Bologna.

The Pacific front: Artillery shelled enemy positions on two Japanese were compressed into small northeast sector; destruction of 10 Japanese divisions on Luzon announced; remaining enemy bottled up in mountains under continuous attack.

WMC COUNSEL PROGRAM SET UP IN STATE

Preliminary plans for adapting to meet local conditions the national war manpower commission program for employment counseling have just been announced by L. C. Stoll, state WMC director.

The national plan, Stoll said, provides for specialized employment counseling, specifically for veterans, physically handicapped persons, displaced war workers and new entries into the labor market such as students.

In Oregon, the plan provides that over a period of about six months counselors for local offices of the United States employment service will be thoroughly trained in counseling techniques. The training, however, and the setting up of this service will not be available in all parts of the state immediately, according to Stoll.

Before counseling service is available, public announcements will be made in every local uses area. Such a service will be preceded by working arrangement with government and private agencies and organizations which are interested in the occupational adjustment of its citizens. This, it has been decided, will secure the best coordination possible and make use of all local resources, Stoll said.
