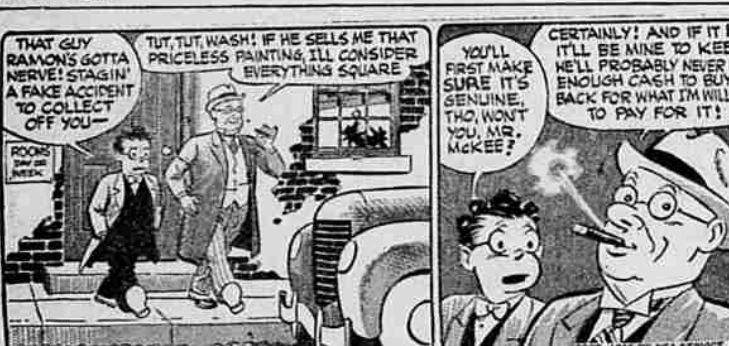

D. A. Denies Jap Land Possession

PORTLAND, March 22 (AP)—A district attorney's opinion held today that a Japanese with two sons in the armed forces has no authority to obtain immediate possession of land the sons leased to the county.

B. Fujii made formal demand for possession of the property, adjoining the county farm, so he could plow the alfalfa tract and plant his own crops. The county commissioners desire to retain possession until after the hay and grain harvest this summer.

The opinion was written by Deputy District Attorney Stanley M. Jones. It said the lease agreement remains in effect to March, 1944, or until the return of the sons or their families, and that until the latter appear to make their own demand the county cannot release the property.

Ration Calendar

War Price and Rationing Board, 420 Main street. Office hours daily 10 a. m. to 4:30 p. m. Phone 6101 for all information.

All applications must be MAILED in to the War Price and Rationing Board at 420 Main street, and NOT presented in person.

PROCESSED FOODS:
BLUE STAMPS—Ration book 4—Blue stamps X-1 through X-2 valid through March 31. Blue stamps C-2 through C-5 valid through April 30. Blue stamps H-2 through H-3 valid through June 2. Blue stamps N-2 through N-3 valid through June 30.

RED STAMPS: Ration book 4—Red stamps Q-3 through Q-5 valid through March 31. Red stamps T-5 through T-5 valid through April 30. Red stamps V-5 through V-2 valid through June 2. Red stamps K-2 through J-2 valid through June 30.

SUGAR: Ration book 4—Sugar stamp 35 valid through June 2.

SHOES: Ration book 3—Airplane stamps 1, 2 and 3 now valid. Loose stamps invalid.

GASOLINE: "A" 11 coupons, 4 gallons each, valid through March 31. "B" 11 coupons, 4 gallons each, valid through June 21.

STOVES: Apply local board for oil, gas, stove certificates.

WOOD, COAL, SAWDUST: Dealer determines delivery priority from consumer's written statement of annual needs and quantity on hand.

FUEL OIL: Period 1-5 (inclusive) coupons valid through August 31. Not more than 75 per cent of season's ration should have been used to date in Portland area. 75 per cent in Roseburg area and 80 per cent in North Head area.

PRICE CONTROL: Refer inquiries and complaints to price clerk at local board.

RENT CONTROL: In areas under Federal rent control, all rented dwelling units must be registered, and changes in tenancy reported.
