(Continued From Page One) ing as one of the worst debacles in Prussian military history.

At Remagen, some 100 miles to the north, we hold a FIRM bridgehead OVER the Rhine. Seventy-odd miles farther to the north three allied armies (the Canadian 1st, the British 2nd and the U. S. 9th) are massed under a smoke screen on the Rhine's west bank and the German radio says a crossing is imminent.

SO much for the Rhine front. At Stettin, on the Oder, the Russians have opened a bombardment on what is reported as an unprecedented scale.

THE north German plain is ideal tank country. The German radio reports today that we have put into action our new General Pershing super tank, mounting guns of approximately 4-inch caliber—bigger than the German 88.

MEANWHILE—Stalin announces today the launching of a new red offensive from the upper Oder through the historic Moravian gate leading to Vienna and thence, along the valley of the Danube, to the German border.
