A NEW problem in service men's hospitality has developed out of recent changes in the status of the one-time officers' club at the Willard hotel.

These quarters were operated as a club for commissioned officers for more than a year, and rendered an excellent service in that respect. However, there developed a serious manpower and management problem for the Elks lodge, the sponsor, and recently the Elks sold the equipment to the Marine Staff Non-Commissioned Officers club.

That gives the staff non-coms a finely appointed lay-out, and nicely rounds out the marine downtown recreation program.

The solution of one problem seems to have created another. Navy officials state there is still a definite need for a recreation center in the city for navy men, officers, especially the junior squadron commissioned officers. These are the young fellows who are here while undergoing final training in the air for combat duty. They do not have time while here to establish such social contacts as do the permanent personnel officers, and many of them do not have their families with them. They have been the most regular visitors at the Elks Officers' club.

Need Described
COMMANDER R. R. DARRON, air station C. O., says there is a definite need for a club down town for them. That need was recognized a year ago when the Elks started their enterprise. Since then, officers' lounges have been opened at both the air station and the barracks, but it is still felt by the navy head that the young squadron officers, especially, should have a downtown spot.

The marine staff NCO's are so happily situated and will make such excellent use of their club that one cannot regret they were able to get it. We are so glad they are so well set up. At the same time, some serious thought should be given to the other problem. Townspeople, we believe, will be willing to cooperate, through organizations or otherwise, but the motivation might well come from the air station in the way of a project such as those which have resulted in the establishment of other clubs. Groups or individuals looking for something to do in the hospitality program might look into this problem.

Fish Price Mark-Ups Scheduled by OPA

WASHINGTON, April 4 (P)—OPA today announced price mark-ups to be used by retailers in fixing their selling prices on north Atlantic and Pacific fresh fish and seafood for the summer season, which runs from April through September.

The mark-ups, effective April 12, are with one exception the same as those used last summer. Following the seasonal price pattern, they will result in lower prices to consumers of from 2 to 5 cents a pound below the winter prices.

The retail mark-up for lemon sole fillets was increased slightly over that in effect last summer, in order to cover a previous increase granted in fishermen's prices for that species.

News Behind the News

WASHINGTON, April 4—The yarn they are passing around about the resignation of James F. Byrnes as assistant president is that he was angry about having been turned down for the vice-presidency by Mr. Roosevelt at the last Chicago convention.

That is rather stale anger. But about a week before the president made the announcement of the resignation, certain senators heard he was angry again. They did not know about what—or did not say.

He had just returned recently from the Yalta conference, and if he was angry about that it did not show. As a matter of fact, Mr. Byrnes' face barely shows anything. It is the best poker countenance in town.

He could also possibly have been angry about the unpopular reaction to his ban on horse racing and after midnight saloons, in certain quarters at least. That could not be true. Objecting quarters certainly did not include the office of the chief executive.

Won Night Club Fight

BYRNES won his battle over Mayor LaGuardia on the nightclub closing with some adroit pressure from the army and navy by the simple process of having servicemen get up and leave night clubs at the midnight hour.

Anyone who remained was thereby placed in the position of being unpatriotic, and not even the mayor's friends, the nightclub owners, could stand that kind of a flanking maneuver. They quit their battle forthwith and left the mayor shrieking—but alone.

As a follow-up to the other bans came recent announcements that all would be withdrawn upon V-E day, and that the army man in the Byrnes office who inspired them was moved to France to serve out the war. There is nothing in this picture but happiness at both ends of the White House, the east wing where Mr. Byrnes operated and the west wing where the president worked.

You will recall, however, that Mr. Roosevelt's reply to the resignation letter, said he was "familiar" with Mr. Byrnes' "persistent" efforts to resign. That was plain, polite sarcasm, lending more than credence to the inside senate information but doubling it.

Furthermore Byrnes acted in obvious haste on his promise to stay on to V-E day. He anticipated it by an indefinite period, with his announcement, although agreeing to stay on until then.

Known Sore Points

THE only anger Byrnes has expressed to his friends that I know has been against the march of events toward socialism or radicalism or whatever you want to call the movement on the march. He could well have come away from Yalta with some reflections on how little we won there.

Practically everyone is a little "sore" about that, but perhaps more displeased that Stalin has not seen fit even so, to honor the San Francisco conference, the air conference and many other administration plans with cooperation.

Byrnes' failure to "clear it with Sidney" for the vice presidency had the political foundation of his resistance to the left wing. This is the fundamental cause for his resignation. Whatever anger arose, must have sprung from that basic source.

Furthermore, the main effect will be to add one more name to the list of those of his viewpoint passing from posts of power.

ATTEMPT TO HARM PRESIDENT FOILED

CEUTA, Spanish Morocco, April 4 (P)—A Nazi observation post prepared to relay information to waiting U-boats was wiped out eight hours before President Roosevelt's ship passed through the Strait of Gibraltar homeward bound from Yalta, it has been learned on good authority.

The post, in a private house in Ceuta perched on a high cliff overlooking the strait, was said to have been operated by Spanish Falangist agents in pay of the Germans. It was raided by American officials with Spanish assistance. A powerful radio transmitter and German code books were seized.

Earlier raids against suspected Nazi espionage posts in Spanish Morocco, opposite Gibraltar, were said to have failed. With the approach of the president's convoy American officials in Tangier went to Tetuan, Spanish Morocco, where Spanish officials, although skeptical, agreed to send a Spanish military officer to escort the American raiding party.
