 April 11 (AP)—Dr. Bela Fabian, president of the dissolved Hungarian democratic party, said in an interview today that 5,000 Jews had been gassed and cremated at a murder factory at Auschwitz.
 Fabian said he was taken to Auschwitz 10 months ago with 10 other Hungarian Jews. He said that 400,000 Jews had been gassed in the first two years and that only 1000 remained alive.

MINISTER'S AGED WIFE BUILDS HOME

PARKVILLE, Mo., April 11 (AP)—Ailing Gassaway Johnson, 94-year-old former slave and Baptist minister, has a home of his own again, built by his 84-year-old wife from the ruins of the one destroyed by fire two years ago.
 There aren't any doors or windows—she hasn't been able to get any lumber for those luxuries—but there's a roof and that's the main thing during this rainy season.
 The former Johnson home burned down two years ago. There was \$700 insurance, but Mrs. Johnson, unfamiliar with wartime regulations, didn't make application for lumber to rebuild within the required ten days. Her application, she says, "went to Washington and hasn't come back."
 They lived in the Baptist parsonage until the church hired a new pastor. Then they had to leave.
 Finally, Mrs. Johnson got enough lumber with the help of the federal housing administration to furnish one room.
 The native stone foundation of the old six-room house serves as walls for the new one-room house. In ten days she laid a floor and put up a roof.

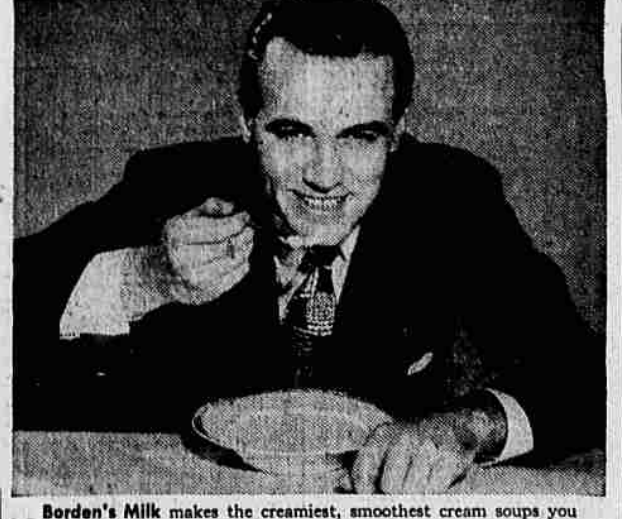

Savage Says Company Adds to Labor Lack

WASHINGTON, April 11 (AP)—Rep. Charles Savage (D-Wash.) filed with the senate small business committee yesterday a declaration that the Aluminum Company of America was "deliberately maintaining sub-standard wages and working conditions so they will be unable to get men."
 "This," Savage contended before the committee yesterday, "gives them the excuse to say

they are unable to get labor to produce aluminum in the Pacific northwest and is in keeping with their usual monopolistic practices. Such a practice will bring about the closing of the northwest plants."

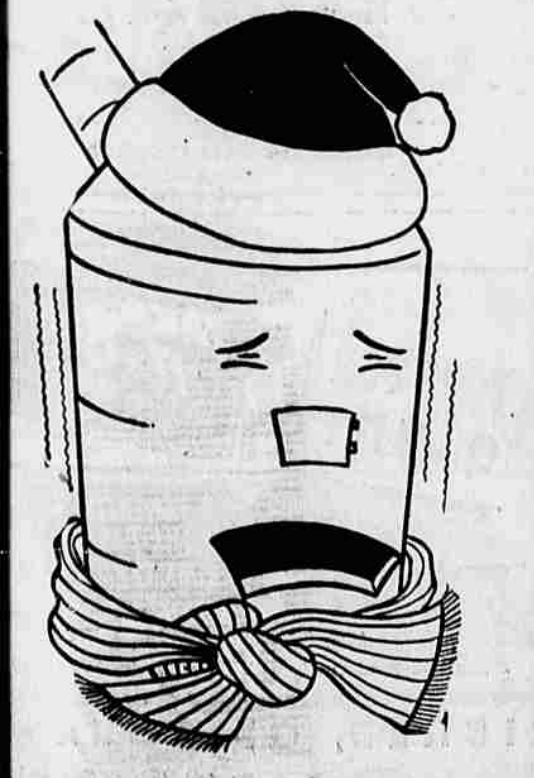
