Some 325 miles south of Japan the U. S. 7th division captured high ground near the Okinawa village of Ishin. It was the first noteworthy change in the front since last Thursday when the American offensive opened. And it offered first hopeful possibilities of a breach in the Naha line—an interminable network of caves, blockhouses, trenches and pillboxes. No other change was reported.

**NAVY TAKES OVER
BAY CITY COMPANY**

WASHINGTON, April 25 (AP)—President Truman today ordered the navy to seize and operate the plants of the United Engineering Company, Ltd., at San Francisco where a jurisdictional dispute has tied up work on several ships.

The order directed the secretary of the navy to take possession of all, or such parts, as he deems necessary, of the main office and machine shops.

Officials said that this was the first time that the government has taken over a war plant as a result of a labor jurisdictional dispute.
