No funds were available to purchase five bottles each of scotch, bourbon, blends and brandy so the commission voted to go to the rescue.

### Lack of Lumber May Harm War, Says Krug

WASHINGTON, April 27 (AP)—Unless increased lumber output can be achieved, lack of that material will "interfere directly with the prosecution of the war against Japan," Chairman J. A. Krug of the war production board said today. Krug declared in a statement that war demand for lumber will increase after V-E day because of the accelerated military activity in the Pacific and a sustained demand for a few months in Europe, chiefly for trans-shipping war materials.
