MRS. C. F. BECK PASSES AWAY IN HOSPITAL

Mrs. Charles Fremont Beck, former Klamath county pioneer, passed away at the Klamath Valley hospital Saturday afternoon following a brief illness.

Mrs. Beck was born in Wasco county near The Dalles in 1866 and was raised in Jacksonville, Ore., where her father was a gold discoverer in the early days.

In 1900, this well-known pioneer came to Klamath Falls where she lived the remainder of her life.

Survived by 18 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. Services will be held at Ward's Funeral home on Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock.
