

MORSE URGES LIBERALIZED RIGHTS BILL

WASHINGTON, May 10 (AP)—If the "GI bill of rights" is to accomplish what congress intended, it must be implemented and liberalized, in the opinion of Senator Morse (R-Ore.)

stitutions, told the senate that not only the educational section of the bill but provisions relative to loans and medical attention for veterans also must be improved.

"Possibly the law should be rewritten, but it can be amended intelligently," he told the senate. "I think we need go through the law now and make it possible for the veterans really to take advantage of what congress had in mind when the law was passed."

Morse told reporters he had information indicating that 70 per cent of veterans seeking educational aid would be married men and that 30 per cent of the student body of accredited colleges would be veterans.

His bill provides three approaches to the housing situation: (1) Loans at 2 per cent to public agencies, including the university itself; (2) federal financing, and (3) increased subsistence allowances to take care of inflated rentals.

Asserting that there are few college towns where veterans can house themselves and their families for less than \$50 or \$60 a month, Morse declared that "the educational facilities provided by the GI bill will be valueless because the sum provided for this purpose (\$75 a month) will leave little for tuition and other college expenses."

TWO MILLION MEN TO LEAVE IN 9 MONTHS

WASHINGTON, May 10 (AP)—Approximately 2,837,000 troops will be moved out of Europe within nine months, the army disclosed today.

Within 12 months, the army expects to have out of Europe 3,100,000 troops, leaving only an occupation force estimated at 400,000.

The majority of these soldiers will come to the United States

for redeployment to the Pacific area or for discharge from the army. The others will be routed direct to the Pacific.

About 45,000 soldiers, including many who have been prisoners of the Germans, will be returned to this country by air and surface ships during this month.

Maj. Gen. Charles P. Gross, chief of the army transportation

corps, outlined at a news conference this schedule for the movement of troops from the European and Mediterranean theaters:

Approximately 845,000 men or an average of slightly more than 280,000 a month, will be withdrawn during the first three months following V-E Day.

Approximately 1,185,000, or

an average of 395,000 a month, will be moved out during the second three months.

About 807,000 or 269,000 a month, will be shifted during the third three months.

After that, the redeployment will be carried on until only the occupation force of some 400,000 is left. Gross said that all of those troops who are destined to be brought out under the redeployment program should leave Europe within a year.

After the last World War, required 10 months to evacuate 2,000,000 troops.




