SPAR RECRUITERS VISIT IN KLAMATH

Because the war is far from finished, the Spars of the United States coast guard are still recruiting young women to help speed the fall of Japan, according to Maxine Balch, Sp (R) 1/c. and Patricia McHugh, Y 1/c. who are visiting in Klamath Falls on Monday and Tuesday from the recruiting station at Portland. Women from the ages of 20 to 36, and especially those with office training and experience are needed by the coast guard.

The two recruiters are staying at the Willard hotel while here, and may be contacted there by anyone interested. The women reservists are helping the coast guard meet its growing need for men on the sea lanes of the expanding Pacific war. Spars have already replaced thousands of men on shore jobs, thereby releasing them for sea duty, but the demand is heavy for additional thousands in the Pacific theater of war.

Spar recruits must be American citizens, have at least two years of high school or business school, be at least 56 inches tall, have no dependents, under 18 and have vision at least correctible to 20/30. Complete information may be secured from the coast guard recruiting station at 806 SW Morrison street, Portland (5), Oregon.

Accompanying the Spar recruiters on their present tour of southern Oregon is Lyle Kruger, MOMM 1/c. from the 13th naval district coast guard recruiting office at Seattle. Kruger, a veteran of two years' wartime sea duty, is meeting with high school principals and others in the interests of various coast guard programs.
