## Donald Nelson Named Producers President

HOLLYWOOD, June 13 (AP)—Donald M. Nelson will become president of the Society of Independent Motion Picture Producers on June 29.

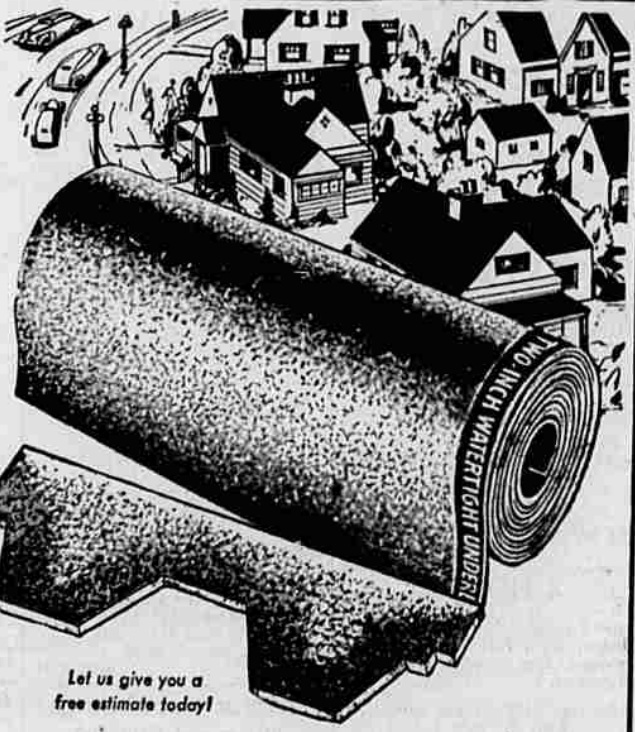
