PROCESSED FOODS:
BLUE STAMPS—Ration book 4—Stamps N-2 through P-2 valid through June 30. Stamps Q-2 through X-2 valid through July 31. Stamps Y-2, Z-2, A-1, B-1 and C-1 valid through August 31. Stamps D-1 through H-1 valid June 1.
