

# NEW PUMICITE INDUSTRY SET TO WEAR CHEMULT

An industry dealing with pumicite will be set up about one mile this side of Chemult, according to James Hunter, superintendent in charge of Harold's Club Mining Company of Reno, Nev. Plans for this project have been underway since last August, Hunter said today, and a number of trademarks have been filed in Washington D. C. Equipment is in the process of being moved to Chemult from Reno and Prineville with the conveyor and screens. The cost of the business will consist of shipping pumicite in gondolas and boxcars for building roads to a point west of Chemult, Colo., Hunter declared. A pumicite will then be crushed to bricks and tiles. A minimum of four men will be employed by the company on 46 acres of pumicite land which has been purchased in the Chemult area. A total expenditure of \$50,000 has been made on the project, he stated. Production will start the last part of July with Alex Raney, also of Reno, in charge of the new company, Hunter said.

# STUDENTS ATTEND SUMMER SCHOOL

# Sawdust Barge Guttled By Fire In Canal

VICTORIA, B. C., June 20 (CP)—Damage estimated at more than \$30,000 was done to the island carrier, largest sawdust barge of the Island Tug and Barge, Ltd., when she was gutted by flames Saturday in the Alberni canal, Captain H. R. Robinson, manager of the firm, said today. Origin of the fire is as yet undetermined.

Nearly 2000 units of fir hog fuel, destined for Port Angeles, Wash., as well as decks, wheelhouse, machinery and all gear aboard the former four-masted bark Somal were destroyed.

After being refloated the vessel will be towed to Port Angeles.
