

SLOT MACHINES LOCAL PROBLEM, SNELL CLAIMS

SALEM, July 10 (AP)—Governor Earl Snell, commenting on Portland newspaper reports about the existence of slot machines in Portland, said today that action against the machines is the responsibility of local officials, but the state agencies would help upon the request of the local officials.

The governor said in a prepared statement:

"I wish to recall to mind that several months ago I forwarded to the local officials of several counties a list of those counties in which machines were alleged to be operating and at which time I called attention to provisions of the law which placed responsibility on local officials. The list was printed in a Salem newspaper, and the information as to the machines came from the special licensing division of the state tax commission."

"Reports reaching this office indicate that the officials took immediate action. However, the story from Portland appearing this morning indicates that a condition now exists in some sections of that city."

"While under Oregon law, action in connection with these matters is clearly a responsibility of local officials, the state law and enforcement agencies stand ready to render any and every assistance upon request from local officials. This has been demonstrated very recently in several instances. Furthermore, this office interprets the laws to mean that in event the situation is out-of-hand locally, the executive department has very definite obligations and responsibilities."

Pleads Guilty To Burglary Charge

Marvin H. Adams was arraigned Thursday morning before Circuit Court Judge David R. Vandenberg charged with burglary not in a dwelling. He pleaded guilty to the charge and sentence will be passed Monday at 10 a. m.

Adams admitted burglarizing the Klamath county agricultural experimental station on May 25. Several articles were stolen including a microscope valued at \$150.

He was on three-year probation for burglarizing the Merrill Billiards at Merrill when he was arrested on the present charge.

Arnold P. Edsall, 4042 Delaware, was fined \$30 in police court recently for failure to procure a cab driver's license and for failing to report an accident.
