

MEMORIAL AT COURT HOUSE GETS PAINTING

Repainting of the memorial shaft on the courthouse lawn is now in progress, two coats of paint being applied to both shaft and base.

Names on the monument are those of Klamath basin men who have made the supreme sacrifice in the war.

It has been the policy of the Klamath war memorial committee (appointed jointly by the county judge and mayor of Klamath Falls) to place on the shaft names of men who have died in military service and who have been residents of the Klamath basin, or whose immediate family has been, or are residing in the area.

The family is consulted by the committee before the name is placed on the monument.

The committee is anxious to have a complete list of all such casualties and if any omissions are apparent it will be appreciated if the information is left at the office of the chamber of commerce with Mrs. Esther Lawler.

It will be necessary to paint out all the names now on the shaft, but each name will be placed on a thin prestwood plaque and replaced on the shaft.

The scarcity of painters and volume of work has delayed the work on the memorial and the committee wishes to assure all interested people that the delay was not caused by lack of interest by the city.

SEWING PROJECT NEARS COMPLETION

The local chapter of the American Red Cross has completed the spring quota for sewing with the exception of 500 ditty bags and 500 housewives. The finished goods have been shipped to San Francisco to the American Red Cross there and will be distributed overseas or to service men in hospitals.

Among the articles shipped were 361 pairs of bedroom slippers, 25 bathrobes, nine bed jackets for men; 20 lap robes, 348 ditty bags, 110 housewives and 225 olive drab kits.

Material for 200 wash cloths, which are still to be completed, as well as for the ditty bags and housewives, can be obtained at the Red Cross headquarters.

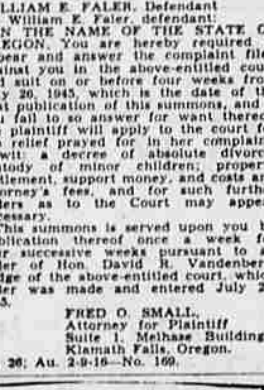

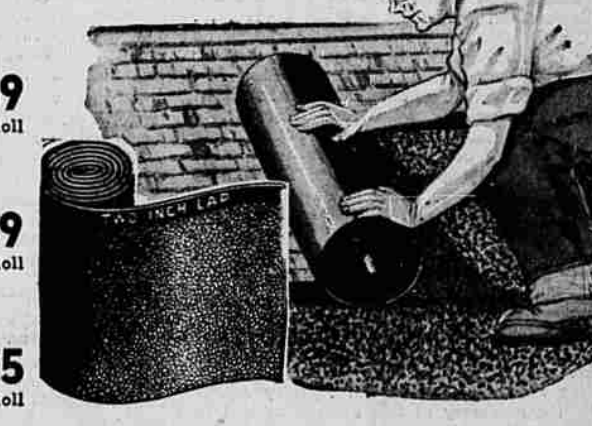
