which tore ahead for 106 miles yesterday, approached Putele pass, 4000-foot passage through the great Kiang range, after capturing the highly important railway town and base of Hulín (Hallar). This force was driving toward Harbin and 30 miles inside the Manchurian frontier.

Edge Up Mountain
The tip of the eastern pincer edged up the Wan mountains in the region of Muling, between Harbin and Vladivostok, the Russian base on the Sea of Japan. Muling is 200 miles east of Harbin and 30 miles inside the Manchurian frontier.

More Countries Join
Moreover, the Mongolian Peoples republic, soviet Russia's protectorate in outer Mongolia, had entered the war against Japan, and another operation loomed against the Japanese—an invasion by famed Mongolian cavalry units down the historic caravan route from Ulan Bator through inner Mongolia to Peiping, former capital of China.

No New Reports
There were no new reports, meanwhile, either from Tokyo or Moscow on the extent of the reported invasions of the southern half of Sakhalin island and Korea—Moscow has not mentioned these fronts, where the Japanese radio said penetrations had been made in force.

Nimitz Awaits Official Notice

GUAM, Sunday, Aug. 12 (AP)—Admiral Nimitz awaited official notification from the navy department today that the allies had conditionally accepted the Japanese surrender proposal and said he would take no action until those orders were received.

War's End Brings Little Extra Sugar

WASHINGTON, Aug. 11 (AP)—Ending of the war with Japan would give civilians "at best, only a slight increase in sugar for some time," a spokesman for the agricultural department said today.

ARMY INVESTIGATES LUMBER STRIKE HERE

that "The union stands ready and willing to meet and discuss this question at any time with any of the company officials concerned."

A spokesman for the Kesterson Lumber corporation, one of the struck plants, said this morning that in his opinion the Kesterson strike was illegal and that he hoped the men would return to work. "The company officials and the negotiating committee for the IWA-CIO union met Thursday night at which time the union demanded a union shop and refused to negotiate for anything else. The union gave the company no warning that it had intentions of striking the plant the next morning," he stated.

1787 Idle Now
The strike figure zoomed to 1787 yesterday when the Kesterson Lumber corporation, Kesterson box factory, and Ewauna Box company were struck by CIO unionists. The strike, aimed at a 27 1/2 cents an hour wage increase and a union shop, already had hit the huge Weyerhaeuser Timber company mill and its woods operations, and the Chiloquin Lumber company and Bly Logging company logging camps.

Navy Announces Bonfish Loss
