JAP PUPPET IN PHILIPPINES IS READY TO DIE

YOKOHAMA, Sept. 6 (AP)—Jose Laurel, who was president of the Japanese puppet government in the Philippines was quoted today by CBS Correspondent Felix Busto as saying "If our people decide I was guilty of disloyalty and treason I am ready to be shot."

Busto said he had located Laurel in Nara, near the ancient city of Kyoto, where he set up a refugee government after a perilous journey to Japan last June.

Test Case
Laurel contended his case should be a test on the collaboration issue.

"If the commonwealth government contemplates to try leading leaders of the Philippines who participated in the republic for their acts," Busto quoted Laurel in an interview, "I submit that they be spared that responsibility and try me instead, first and solely."

Laurel declared other leaders who worked with him should be set free as they merely followed the policies, opportunities and limitations of his government.

Busto said he described the destruction of Manila to Laurel, who bowed his head. Tears came to Laurel's eyes as he said: "Yanashita (Japanese general in the Philippines) fooled me, when he asked me to leave Manila for Baguio. He assured me he wouldn't defend Manila."

Mutual Admiration Pact

JAP ENVOY DENIES ATTACK KNOWLEDGE

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 6 (AP)—Saburo Kurusu, Japanese special envoy who was discussing peace in Washington at the moment of the sneak attack on Pearl Harbor, was quoted today as contending that he knew nothing of the raid plans and was "deeply hurt" by the American accusation that he was bait for the trap.

Frederick C. Opper, American Broadcasting company correspondent, also quoted Kurusu as reiterating: "I did not know anything about the attack on Pearl Harbor before I left Tokyo. As a matter of fact, I found Prime

Minister Tojo more optimistic about chances for peace than I was. I told him I thought things were very precarious in the Pacific and when I met President Roosevelt a little later I told him the same thing—that a single spark could start war in the Pacific."

North Bend Air Station To Close

COOS BAY, Sept. 6 (AP)—Naval officials said today the auxiliary air station at North Bend will close September 15 and only a few maintenance personnel will be retained until disposition of facilities is determined.

Lt. Comdr. C. M. Merkel said only one squadron is now stationed at the base and 21 aerial squadrons have been trained since the \$2,000,000 station was commissioned in 1943.

The 50 buildings required a staff of 700 military and 125 civilian personnel at the peak of operations.
