**CELEBRATES SURRENDER**  
 ABOARD THE USS NEVADA IN THE PACIFIC—Charles E. Cummings, S 1/c, USNR, 521 Jefferson, Klamath Falls, celebrated the surrender of Japan aboard this famous American battleship as she rested at anchor in Leyte gulf after a 32-day mission into the East China sea.

The announcement by the commanding officer, Capt. Homer Louis Groskopf, USN, of Minneapolis, Minn., that the Japanese had quit touched off a demonstration unlike any this veteran ship had ever seen. Sailors tossed their hats in the air and began jiggerbugging to the strains of the ship's band. It was "Holiday Routine" for all hands.

**Red Airline Plans Puzzle CAB**  
 WASHINGTON, Sept. 13 (AP)—A statement in the Russian newspaper Izvestia that a soviet-operated airline had been opened to the United States by way of Alaska and Yakutsk, Siberia puzzled officials today.

Although official comment indicated that an opening move by the Russians would be welcome, the civil aeronautics board said Russia has not applied for official air rights in the United States. The state department said there have been none of the negotiations which normally would precede such an application.
