Development of a program of social hygiene education under the Klamath County Public Health association is being correlated with statewide organizations with meetings being held this week with teachers, PTA groups and home extension units throughout the county.

Mrs. George Moorhead, chairman of the social hygiene committee of the Oregon Congress of Parents and Teachers, and F. G. Scherer, director of the division of Social Hygiene Education of the Oregon Tuberculosis association, were here from Portland to speak before various groups on the problems of social hygiene.

Program Reviewed
At a meeting of the county PTA Tuesday morning, Mrs. Moorhead reviewed the program recommended by her department toward the organization of study groups to give parents information for home use on social hygiene. The aim of groups is to preserve and strengthen the family.

Tuesday afternoon the two guests, introduced by Mrs. Thomas Parker, executive secretary of the Klamath County Public Health association, spoke at a meeting of a home extension unit at the Midland grange hall.

Reasons Given
Scherer outlined the reasons why the subject of social hygiene should be in the public mind at this time and Mrs. Moorhead spoke on the answering of questions of small children.
