Woman's Murderer Sentenced To Hang

Mrs. Rogers was stabbed in the throat. Main witnesses at the trial were Maxine Leone Rogers, 15, and Walter Ernest Rogers, 13, children of the woman. They testified Potter was in the cabin when their mother was killed and they heard Potter say: "There that's done," as he knelt on the floor beside their mother.

62-Year-Old Woman Would Blaze A Trail To Alaska

SEATTLE, Oct. 3 (AP)—Mrs. Miriam Mathers, hale and 62, is going to get her covered wagon, three horses and four goats to Alaska yet.

Ever since she left Big Piney, Wyo., on Thanksgiving day, 1940, Mrs. Mathers has been knocking at the Canadian border, hoping to blaze a trail to Alaska.

Yesterday she was in Seattle arranging passage for her little

caravan aboard an Alaska-bound ship. The sturdy little woman, a widow 18 years, told a Post-Intelligencer reporter she had thought maybe she'd get across when the Alaska military highway was completed "but the authorities wouldn't let me do that, either."

They kept turning her back and refusing to let her try the trip through the wilderness be-

cause, she said, "No white woman had ever done it."

"I've tried every way to get to Alaska—I even wrote to Premier Mackenzie King."

Now that water passage has been arranged she plans to get off at Seward. "Then I'll hitch up my team and find me a home. I think some of the restlessness will be out of me by then."

mar, Philippine islands area, on October 24, 1944.
