

FUND BENEFITS LAKE 'O WOODS CAMP PROGRAM

Among beneficiaries of the 1945 Community Fund are the Camp Fire Girls and Girl Scouts.

These two groups maintain a summer camp jointly at Lake 'o Woods by fund allotments. One hundred Camp Fire Girls enjoyed the camp this year, which was opened for two weeks for them.

Receive Counsel
The girls receive counsel, instruction in swimming, handicraft, horseback riding and they also participate in outdoor and indoor recreation.

When this group vacates the camp, Girl Scouts take over for two weeks and receive the same character-building benefits.

There are 20 groups of Camp Fire Girls now, and allotments from the 1945 Community Fund will be used to organize new groups and extend the program.

Camp Cabins Needed
Permanent camp cabins are needed. At present the only permanent building is used for the dining hall and an indoor recreation hall.

Erecting permanent camp facilities with sturdy cabins is the long-range plan of both organizations using the camp.

25th Began Combat When 2 Months Old

Two months after it was activated, the 25th or "Tropical Lightning" division, was burying its dead. No other division in the history of the U. S. army ever saw combat so soon after it was formed.

Activated from elements of the Hawaiian division's regular army troops in October, 1941, it fought the Japs at Pearl Harbor in December.

The 25th got its first chance to pay the Japs back early in 1943, when the division cleared for Guadalcanal. The doughboys hit the open beaches west of the Tenaru river. The rough and broken terrain made supply, communication and evacuation of wounded extremely difficult, but the doughs slamed forward and butchered the enemy.

After months of training, the 25th joined in the New Georgia fight for Munda airfield. Then the men cleaned up Arundel island and fought a bloody battle to secure Vella La Vella. The "Tropic Lightnings" land-

ed on Luzon two days after the initial assault and went into the line a week later, attacking between the Sixth and 43rd divisions. It fought a five-day battle for the town of San Manuel. The 25th's brilliant assistant commander, Brig. Gen. James Leo Dalton II, was killed in the fight.

OLD AGE PENSION
LONDON, Oct. 12 (AP)—The British Press association said today that labor members of parliament were hoping to increase the basic old age pension from the present rate of 10 shillings (\$2) per week to 20 or 30 shillings.

Approximately 4,000,000 persons now are receiving pensions.

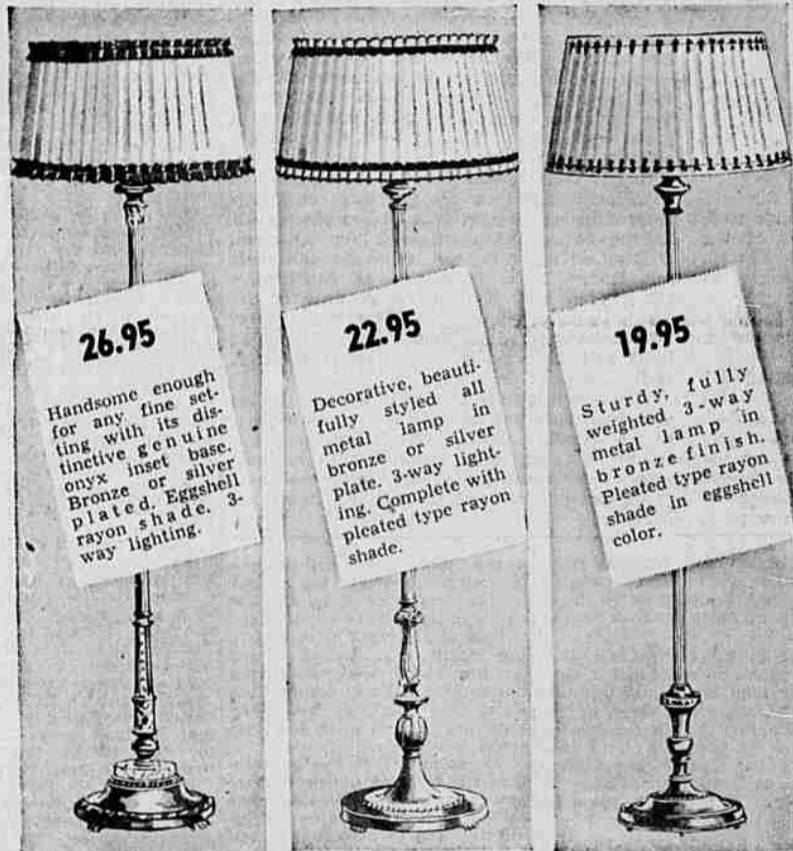

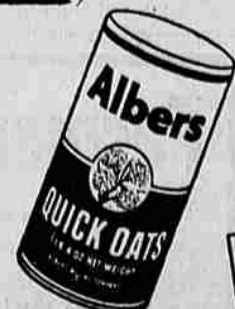

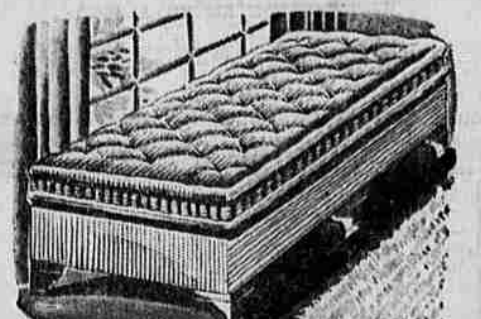
