

# TECHNICALITY HALTS ACTION OF COMMITTEE

LONDON, Oct. 24 (AP) — Snagged on a question of parliamentary order, the United Nations executive committee postponed today a vote on a Russian request that the nominations committee of the organization's general assembly be abolished.

The soviet delegate, Andrei A. Gromyko, reversing his stand in a sub-committee, made the proposal during discussion of a report on the general assembly. Delegates interpreted this move as aimed at strengthening the proposed central committee.

Postponement of the vote was preceded by a briah between the Russian and United States delegates.

**Simple Majority**  
Adlai E. Stevenson, U. S. delegate, held that the nominations committee was a means for efficient handling of elections and the only assurance of a wide geographical distribution of various committee chairmanships.

After a two-hour discussion, he phrased the question so that it would have required only a simple majority to carry.

Gromyko, the soviet ambassador to the United States, objected, insisting that the question be turned around so as to require two-thirds approval.

"I'm surprised at you," he told Stevenson.

Stevenson replied that parliamentary order required consideration of the question as he had put it.

"I don't think we should alter our procedure on items like this," he declared. "At least I don't propose to do so as long as I am chairman."

The committee, unable to determine what question to vote on, decided to postpone the balloting.

## HOFFMAN REVEALS LOBBYIST ACTIVITY

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24 (AP) — The White House met with silence Monday an assertion by Rep. Hoffman (R-Mich.) that a "lobbyist" spent \$75,000 on a party President Truman attended on September 22.

The outing was held at the Jefferson Island club in Chesapeake bay. Among those present were Secretaries Vinson, Schweiker, and Anderson, Attorney General Tom Clark, several dozen members of congress and other Washington figures.

Hoffman declared in a house speech yesterday that M. Arundel "picked up the \$75,000 check which paid for the festivities." He said a congressional investigating committee learned a year ago that Arundel represented many companies in the capital and had a \$1000 a month hotel suite at the expense of the Bulova Watch company.

He suggested the people would like to know whether Mr. Truman "is aware of the activities and the character of the gentleman who financed the party at Jefferson Island."

## BUNKER HILL SAILS INTO PUGET SOUND

SEATTLE, Oct. 24 (AP) — Vice Admiral Marc A. Mitscher's former flagship, the 28,500-ton carrier Bunker Hill entered Puget Sound early Monday, teaming with more than 1000 army veterans, most of them ready for discharge. She sailed from Hawaii.

Known as "The Holiday Inn" because her career started with battles on Christmas, New Year's Day and Armistice Day, the Bunker Hill was last in the sound last summer when she crept into the navy yard at Bremerton the most severely damaged ship ever to put in there for repair. Two kamikaze planes had hit her severely,

causing more than 600 casualties.

The army transport Gen. W. A. Haas disembarked more than 3000 veterans from the Philippines last night. Included were 33 Wacs who worried over their stateside complexions — "atarbrine tan," caused by repeated doses of that malaria treatment.
