

Reign Of Gang Terrorism Mounts In New York City

NEW YORK, Nov. 23 (AP)—Crime and violence mounted in New York City today even as new armed police mobile divisions—the largest motored patrol in the city's history—roamed the streets in combat against a reign of terrorism.

A 28-year-old man, Rocco Loscalzo, was shot to death early this morning in the Greenwich village section. Police, expressing the belief the shooting was a gang slaying, said Loscalzo died under a fusillade of shots fired from a doorway.

Five bullets penetrated his back and two entered his head, they said. Police said Loscalzo was freed on bail October 24, after being arrested on a charge of grand larceny in the theft of \$20,000 in liquor August 30 from a warehouse.

The slaying brought to 66 the number of persons who have met violent deaths in the last 74 days.

Shot in Knee
Audrey Beasley, 19, also reported to police that she was shot in the right knee while crossing a street in downtown Manhattan. She told police she heard the shot and then felt a "sting" in her leg.

In Brooklyn, two men today held up Benjamin Blecher as he opened the Neptune live poultry market in the Sheephead Bay district and took \$4000 from a safe.

Manhattan police rounded up six teen-age youths on charges of carrying weapons in violation of the Sullivan law. A patrolman became suspicious of four inside a Harlem building and he arrested them after one dropped a 22-caliber revolver. Two were arrested in Manhattan by a policeman who said they admitted planning to rob a restaurant. One of them, police said, had brass knuckles in his possession.
