The commission reported packed snow and ice on the Willamette, Santiam, Willamette and The Dalles-California mountain passes, advising that chains be used. The weather was clear in the passes today, and no rain or snow was reported in the state.

The Wilsonville ferry and Independence—Gladys highway were still closed by high water today, but the flood threat had disappeared.

The Columbia river—Old Oregon Trail highway, which had been reported hazardous the past few days, was clear today of snow, ice and frost.

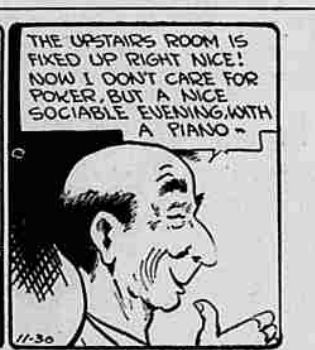

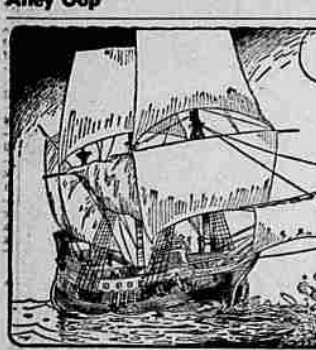
