

U. S. Officials Seek New Methods To Break Iranian Impasse With Russia

WASHINGTON, Dec. 4 (AP)—American officials studied possible new moves in the Iranian impasse today with little evident hope of bringing an early end to big three differences over red army activities there.

Typo Strikers To Talk Offer

SEATTLE, Dec. 4 (AP)—Seattle's striking printers will meet at 5:30 p. m. today. President T. K. Garrison of their Typographical union (AFL) said last night, to decide whether to accept a new proposal from the publishers and return to work. Garrison's report came as the strike, which has tied up publication of the morning Post-Intelligencer and afternoon Times and Star, turned the corner into its third week.

The spokesman said he did not care to reveal the nature of the offer and no statement came from the publishers. The union men left their jobs when they demanded a wage increase of \$2.95 daily and turned down a counter proposal of \$1.65.

viet forces stop interfering with the movement of Iranian troops. And there were no ways immediately apparent by which the United States might impress more emphatically its views upon Moscow.

Problem Studied
It was this problem which had state department diplomats busy today.

The department disclosed Russia's rejection last night. Michael J. McDermott, department news officer, said American troops still are to be withdrawn by year's end. They are leaving now as rapidly as possible, he added.

The United States had told Russia and Britain that if their forces, which divided the country between them for strategic reasons during the war, would also get out now the danger of further incidents in Iran would be ended.

The British have not replied

at all. The Russians are understood to have said they already have agreed with the British to withdraw by March 2—six months after the end of the Japanese war—they see no reason for changing the agreement.

Oppression Feared
What most American officials privately express fear about is the possibility that the things which happen from now on in Iran may show up in some measure as the oppression of a small nation by a great power.

One specific issue still wide open is whether the government at Tehran should be permitted to send its own troops into the province of Azerbaijan where rebellious tribesmen and groups seeking self rule for that area began an uprising about three weeks ago. Thus far Russia has barred the way to the Iranian forces, thus denying them the right to enforce order.

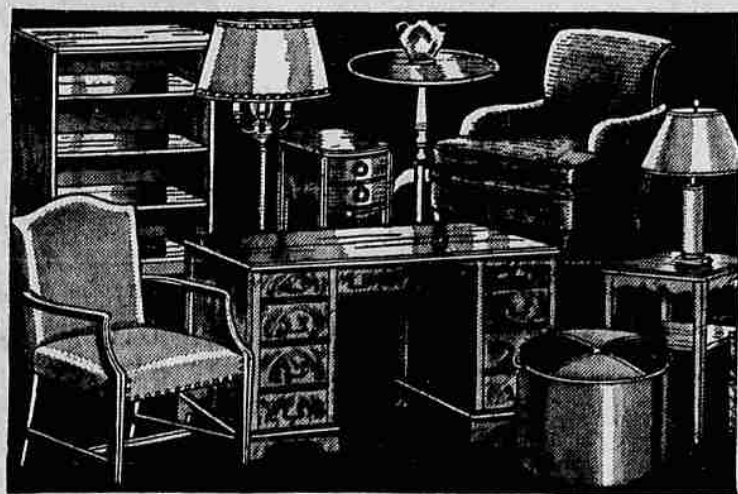
