

Nazis Kidnaped Russian Children For Slave Labor In War Factories

NUEBERG, Dec. 11 (P)—Ten-year-old Russian children were kidnaped for slavery in German war factories as part of the Nazi campaign of "extermination through work," according to evidence submitted today at the war crimes trial of 21 of Hitler's top leaders.

Producing the Germans' own records of mass enslavement of conquered peoples to keep the Nazi war machine running, U. S. Assistant Prosecutor Thomas J. Dodd said the kidnaping policy was approved by Alfred Rosenberg, the party's official philosopher and fifth column expert.

Not only were children kidnaped for slave labor but the abduction also of children of "good blood" was favored by the Gestapo to build up Germany's war-depleted population, other Nazi records disclosed.

Mixed Emotions
The Nazi leaders on trial before the international military tribunal earlier in the day's session watched with mixed emotions a documentary film of the kidnaping in the decade in which Hitler grabbed power and set Germany on the road to aggression and ruin.

Dodd described Defendant Fritz Sauckel, former SS general and high commissioner of labor, as the kingpin of Germany's slave labor.

He read from Heinrich Himmler's speech of October 4, 1943, in which the Gestapo chief told SS leaders:

"Our basic principle must be absolute rule for SS men. We must be honest, decent, loyal and comradely to members of our own blood and to those of other blood. What happens to the Russian and to the Czech does not interest me in the slightest. What nations can offer in the way of good blood of our type we will take, if necessary, by kidnaping their children and raising them for us."

Slavery Policy
The planned policy of enslaving captive peoples for work in German factories and on German farms was "a program of extermination through work," Dodd declared.

Naming others on trial, the prosecutor said that the former munitions minister, Albert Speer, "bears responsibility for the estimate of the number of foreign slaves needed by the German war machine."

Others implicated by Dodd in the forced labor program were Reichsmarschal Hermann Goering, Field Marshal Wilhelm Keitel, Arthur Seyss-Inquart, the Austrian Nazi who opened the frontier of his country to Hitler, and Hans Frank, the governor of conquered Poland.

Film Actress Loses Jewels

HOLLYWOOD, Dec. 11 (P)—Constance Collier, veteran British-born film actress, lost jewels valued at \$3500 at a dinner party November 25 attended by numerous screen notables, a sheriff's report disclosed today.

Miss Collier reported the theft at the time, but asked that no publicity be given it because of the prominence of her guests. A \$2500 platinum ring is among four listed as missing.

Deputy C. E. Gregory, in charge of the investigation, said he considered the guests above suspicion and expressed the belief that the burglar was a prowler.

J. R. McCambridge, who handled seed certification and farm labor here as assistant county agent, has been transferred to Corvallis as assistant seed certification specialist.

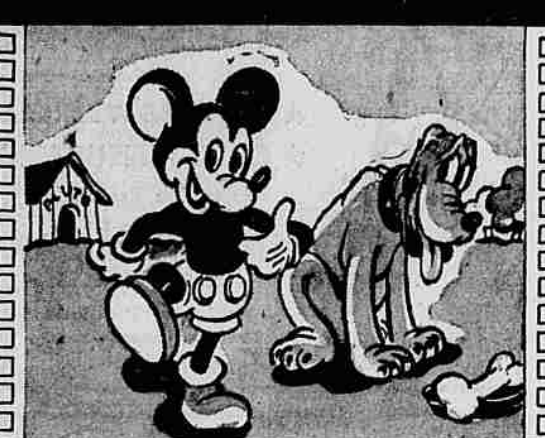
Council OK's City Permits

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Bodies Taken From Plane

LONGVIEW, Dec. 11 (P)—The bodies of five army fliers have been removed from the wreckage of a B-24 bomber found in the rugged Mt. Abernethy district west of Rydewood, local officers reported today. The wreckage of the big plane was found by a group of Rydewood Boy Scouts about a mile from that of another B-24 located a week previously. Soldiers from McChord field arrived at Rydewood yesterday and reached the wreckage last night.

The bodies are now believed to be at McChord field, having been taken there for final identification purposes.

Both of the bombers are believed to have crashed last November 1, when they became separated from two others in a flight south from McChord field during a storm. Cause of the crashes has not been made known.

Forest Fires Burn Over 166,588 Acres
