

Two Men Draw 10-Year Terms

Prison sentences not to exceed 10 years were given Robert Perrington Allen, 23, Modoc Indian from Alluras, and Edward Lee Hill, 25, of Cheyenne, Wyo., yesterday in circuit court, climaxing a brief but wild criminal career for the two young men.

Both were formally charged with larceny of an automobile, but their two-man crime wave also included desertion from the navy for Allen, breaking jail at Port Orchard, Wash., robbery, car thefts and hit-and-run driving.

They were arrested last Thursday by state police after stealing and wrecking a car belonging to Edwin J. Walker of Beatty. While they had Walker's auto they ran down John W. Lee, also of Beatty, on highway 66, then cut across country through a border-strewn field to get away.

They abandoned the car in the field and walked to the Quincy Baker ranch at Beatty, where they were arrested.

Both Hill and Allen pleaded guilty to the car theft charge before Judge David R. Vandenberg.

Nine Klamath Men Join Army

Nine young men, all 18-year-olds, have enlisted in the army from here, making up three-fourths of the county's board 1 and 2 quotas for December 17. William A. Bates, Cleotis M. Hogue and Lyle R. Demory, under board 1, have enlisted and gone to Fort Lewis, Wash., and Robert E. Jameson and Howard R. Woodward are to be inducted December 17.

Under board 2 Billy Gene Collier, Thomas P. Gray, Roger Eugene Eckert, Herman F. Romtvedt, Larry Allison Steppe and Archie Phillip Aten Jr., have enlisted and the board needs one more enlistment from a 1-A man to make its quota before the induction call date.

Veterans re-enlisting do not count toward the draft quotas, but men classified 1-A who voluntarily enlist before being called apply on the quota.
