



# Government Of Austria Recognized

WASHINGTON, Jan. 7 (AP)—The United States formally recognized the government of Austria today and expressed hope that the first nation engulfed by Nazi Germany soon would achieve democracy and complete independence.

Russia, Britain and France joined this country in granting recognition to the Vienna regime headed by Chancellor Leopold Figl and President Karl Renner. The recognition does not affect the authority of the allied council, which will continue to carry out "allied objectives in Austria."

These objectives, the simultaneous announcement said, include "eliminating Nazi influence and institutions in Austria, and assisting in the reconstruction of democratic life."

As they are achieved, the statement added, it is hoped that "a large-scale reduction may be made in the number of occupation troops of the four states (U. S., Russia, Britain, France), and that Austria may progressively acquire status of an independent state."
