CHICAGO, Jan. 31 (AP)—The price of the usually erratic May 1924 was kept on the move faster than usual today over a broad range of rapid fluctuations both above and below yesterday's close.

Cats attracted a fairly two-sided trade mostly of the stay at price only fractionally away from the previous close, while brokers showed little interest in wheat, corn, and barley which remained at ceiling prices.

Wheat, corn and barley closed unchanged from the previous final quotations at ceilings of \$1.80 1/2, \$1.18 1/2 and \$1.23 1/2, respectively; 7/8 unchanged to 3/4c up, May \$2.10 1/2-2.11.
