Caris had been a patient at the hospitals in Portland and Walla Walla since August 15, 1945. He was born May 19, 1880, and final rites for the veteran were held February 2, at Walla Walla.

Caris was the son of Peter W. Caris and Jane Applegate Caris, the latter a direct descendant of the Applegate family, surveyors of the southern route to Oregon. Members of this pioneer family crossed the plains in 1843.

1 cup white sugar
