

Illness Fatal To Ralf Couch

PORTLAND, Ore., March 1 (P)—A prolonged illness was fatal last night to Ralf Couch, 48, administrator of the University of Oregon medical school hospital and clinic, whose work had brought him national recognition.

Couch died in a hospital here, born March 3, 1898, in Elgin, Ore. He was a 1923 graduate of the University of Oregon and a World War I veteran. He served as executive secretary of the medical school and superintendent of the outpatient clinic before assuming administrative duties in 1938.

Survivors include his widow, Vida, and two children, Carolyn and Richard.
