

Citizens Take Cover As Desperadoes Engage In Gun Battle With Police

Two of the men have been captured, an Olympia police officer, Jack Gustan, was slightly wounded as a bullet grazed his arm, and one of two stolen cars was smashed near Vancouver, Wash., after an 80-mile-an-hour chase from Olympia.

The thing began when a Chehalis farmer surprised some men trying to steal his tractor. They fired shots at him then fled in a machine bearing California license plates.

Police, notified and watching for the car, spotted it later in Olympia. As officers approached, men in the car opened fire and during the following exchange of shots, the gunmen raced away. Moments later, officers found the car abandoned, with a bullet hole through the windshield. Inside and on the ground nearby, police found two .38 calibre revolvers, a .22 rifle and a 12 gauge shotgun.

Shortly after, state patrolmen arrested a man trying to hitch a ride on the highway. State Police Sgt. J. D. Fimmel said the man gave his name as Glenn R. Smith, 21. He was booked at Olympia on an open charge.

More Teachers To Quit Jobs

PORTLAND, March 7 (AP)—A warning that about 10 per cent of Oregon school teachers outside of Portland are expected to resign this spring was reported today by the Oregon State Teachers association.

The report based on reports from 70 per cent of the upstate schools and from 57 per cent of the state's teachers was made at a time when school officials revealed they already needed 800 instructors.

The report showed 1164 of 4558 teachers questioned were holding emergency certificates, indicating about 25 per cent of Oregon public school teachers

How to Make Lenten Menus Interesting

If you're looking for meatless main course dishes that are tasty and hearty, here are some of my favorites. These are so good that they needn't be reserved just for Lent. You'll find them delicious the year around.

FRENCH TOAST TUNA SALAD SANDWICH

For a satisfying lunch I serve these sandwiches along with Cream of Pea Soup. Then for dessert I like a Frosted Apple Dumpling and plenty of hot coffee or tea.

Make sandwiches using a well-seasoned tuna salad mixture. For each 3 sandwiches mix together 2 slightly beaten eggs, 1/2 cup of milk and 1 teaspoon salt. Cut sandwiches in half if desired. Dip in egg and milk mixture. Sauté in hot shortening in heavy frying pan, turning to brown both sides. Serve hot.

LIMA BEAN AND CHEESE SALAD

Buttered spinach or Swiss chard, hot bran muffins and chocolate cake for dessert combine with this salad to make a complete supper or lunch.

To 2 cups of cooked dried lima beans, well-drained, add 2 cups finely shredded cabbage, 1 cup American cheese cut in small cubes, and 1/4 cup pickle relish. Toss lightly with Thousand Island Dressing. Serve in bowl lined with cabbage leaves. Serves 6 generously.

NOODLES ROMANOFF

Sour cream gives this dish its distinctive flavor. If you have no sour cream, add 1 tablespoon of lemon juice to a cup of cream or undiluted evaporated milk and let stand for 15 to 20 minutes in a warm place.

Cook a 6-oz. package of egg noodles according to directions on the package. Drain well. Add 1 cup of cottage cheese and 1 cup sour cream and season with 1/4 cup chopped onion, 1 to 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce, a dash of Tabasco or cayenne, salt and paprika. Mix well. Place in casserole and sprinkle with grated sharp cheese or dry bread crumbs. Bake about 40 minutes or until crumbs are brown. Serves 4 to 6.
