

Diplomatic Officials Cite Actions Against Argentina, Spain As Proof New Policy Not Aimed At Reds Alone

WASHINGTON, March 7 (AP)—The country's newly-stressed emphasis on blunt talk in world affairs has some American diplomatic officials worried lest the new policy appear aimed exclusively at the Soviet Union.

(Nikolai V. Novikov, charge d'affaires of the Russian embassy, called on Secretary of State Byrnes today but neither he nor the state department disclosed the purpose of his visit.)

(Novikov took a brief case with him, however, indicating he might have delivered Soviet

replies to the United States notes concerning Iran and Manchuria. (He apologized to reporters for his inability to disclose the nature of his visit, but suggested that, "maybe Mr. Byrnes will give you a hint.")

(A reporter's request for Novikov's comment on world affairs drew this reply: "Some reporters seem to prefer bad news to good.")

Pending these developments, the state department kindled the fires of speculation by announcing that this country's 45,000-ton battleship Missouri will sail from New York March 21 to carry home the body of the late Turkish Ambassador Mehmet Munir Ertegun, dean of the Washington diplomatic corps who died at his post in 1944.

Hunt Pushed For Harvey

Merrill residents and ranchers of the area were demanding today that law enforcement officers go in after Harvey, fearing that he might begin depredations against property and livestock in the district if not apprehended.
