IWA Will Talk New Contract

PORTLAND, March 18 (AP)—Representatives of the CIO International Woodworkers of America and fir operators will discuss industry-wide negotiations of a new contract at conferences here tomorrow.

H. D. Weaver, secretary manager of the lumbermen's industrial relations committee, reported the industry-wide feature of the contract now being negotiated would be discussed, but said progress was stalled in a dispute over status of the termination order of February cancelling contracts expiring April 1.

Weaver said the cancellation cleared the way for negotiations to eliminate wartime clauses. He said, however, the "union claims the contracts are nullified as of April 1 and the employers claim the contracts continue in force and effect after April 1, so long as the parties remain in negotiation."

Union President James W. Fadling said the IWA wanted the cancelled contract reinstated during negotiations and accused the operators of refusing to discuss the contract within the time limit set.

Tomorrow's meetings will be with the Willamette Valley Operators' association, the Oregon Coast Operators' association and the industrial relations committee.

Snow Reported At Odell Lake

SALEM, March 18 (AP)—The state highway commission issued the following road report today:

Santiam Junction—Overcast, 30 degrees, roads normal except for 19-mile stretch east of junction, chains advised. Three inches new snow. Total snow at Summit 161 inches, at Junction 92 inches.

Odell Lake—Snowing, 22 degrees, 156 inches snow at summit. Packed snow east of milepost 53.

Astoria—Wilson river highway has one-way traffic around slide 27 miles east of Tillamook. Lower Columbia highway still closed at east city limits of Astoria because of slide, detouring via Tongue Point naval base.

Meacham—Some snow and slush on Old Oregon Trail highway.

Baker—Snowing.

Bend—Snowing lightly.

John Day—Light rain and snow last night, but highway bare.

Austin—Trace of snow, but none on road.

Wilsonville ferry across Willamette river now operating after being closed by high water.
