

Petitions Support Redistricting Of Siskiyou County

YREKA—A campaign for redistricting of Siskiyou county's supervisory districts was furthered this week with circulation of petitions in the Shasta area requesting the board of supervisors to submit the proposition to a vote of the people.

The redistricting plan was presented to the supervisors at a March 4 meeting by a delegation of representatives from Tulelake, Mount Shasta, Dunsmuir and Weed. Roads Said Normal In High Areas

SALEM, March 20 (AP)—Casualties in mountain passes were today except for short stretches of packed snow, the highway commission said in its daily road report:

Government Camp—Clear, 26 degrees, 108 inches total snow, packed snow and ice between posts 5 and 7 on Wapinitia way.

Antiam Junction — Broken road, 38 degrees, 3 inches snow. Total snow at summit 108 inches. Normal except for packed snow on road in a four-mile stretch east of junction. Chains not required.

Del Lake—Light overcast, 31 degrees. Total snow 160 inches, 2 inches packed snow. Packed snow between mileposts 61 and 67, rest road normal.

Astoria — Lower Columbia way still closed at east city end because of detouring via Tongue Point naval base.

The Dalles — Light snow at higher elevations, road bare.

Seacham—Old Oregon Trail way free of ice and snow. Cabbages on hill.

Werners — Light snow during storm.

SALEM, March 20 (AP)—Voters in the proposed Malheur county Lebanon peoples utility district will vote May 17 on whether the districts should be held. State Engineer Charles Bricklin announced today.

will advocate a charter form of government for the county with supervisors chosen at large in the event the board does not agree to a new redistricting plan.

Presenting a large map of the proposed new districts, according to population, the delegation pointed out population figures in the five districts and asked that the supervisors redistrict the county as equitably as possible.

Not Fair
Under the present system, the group stated, districts four and five, combined, do not have half the population of districts two and three, yet they get two-fifths of the appropriation to Siskiyou county of the state gasoline fund. They declared it is an inequitable distribution on the basis of road mileage in the various districts, as well as on the basis of population.

In answer to inadequate roads, arguments from Tulelake spokesmen who complained that "We're wallowing around in mud over there." Board Chairman W. T. Davidson pointed out their district, number one, was getting a lion's share of all utilities taxes paid in the county coffers and in recent years had been allocated most of the federal road funds.

Davidson further stated that he felt the county is equalized the way it is.

Earl Ager, Tulelake merchant, declared that the citizens committee desired to have the redistricting plan carried through to a successful completion but warned his group would "do it the other way."

Consider Plan
At the close of the meet, the board voted to consider the plan with a report as to their stand, for or against, within 30 days, which will be at their regular session on Monday, April 1.

Below are the proposed new district setups, with population based on the 1940 census and principal towns:

District 1: Population 3097. Tulelake, Dorris, Macdoel, Bray and Tennant.

District 2: Population 8786. Mount Shasta, Dunsmuir and McCloud.

District 3: Population 5629. Weed, Montague, Gazelle and Edgewood.

District 4: Population 5632. Yreka, Grenada, Hornbrook and Hill.

District 5: Population 4487. Etna, Fort Jones, Happy Camp and all of western Siskiyou county.

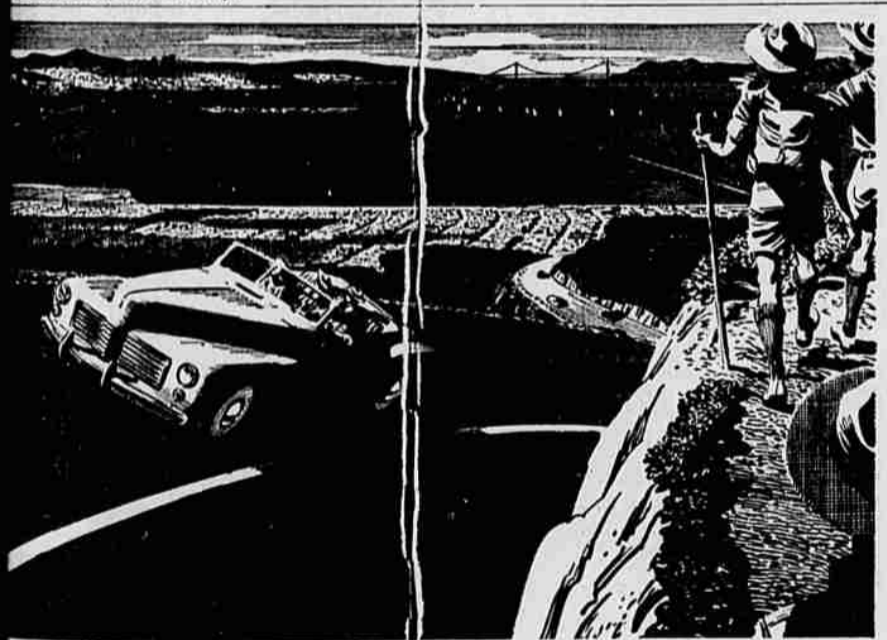
