RESOLUTION NO. 223

WHEREAS, State Highway No. 20, of the State of Oregon, known as the Klamath Falls-Lakeview Highway, is located through the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon, municipal corporation, and the route officially adopted for said highway by the State Highway Commission traverses the following street or streets, or avenues, or roads, or said city, to-wit:

South 6th Street, from a point 227 feet northwesterly from the center line of Owens Street to the south city limits at Shasta Way and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission of the State of Oregon is desirous of receiving Federal Aid for the improvement of said highway, and

WHEREAS, the State Highway Commission has caused a survey to be made, and plans prepared for the improvement of the State Highway traversing the street or streets, or avenues, or roads, as described herein,

WHEREAS, if said proposed street improvement is carried out, the work will be done pursuant to a grade or grades fixed and established by the Highway Commission,

WHEREAS, the grade or grades and elevations to which the proposed improvement will be made are indicated upon the maps and plans prepared for the proposed improvement which are on file in the office of the Oregon State Highway Commission at Salem, Oregon, copies of which have been submitted to the City for its record and for approval, said grades being as follows:

Beginning at grade elevation 4088.22 at a point in the center line of south 6th Street 227 feet northwesterly from the center line of Owens Street; thence to elevation 4088.49 at the center line of Owens Street; thence to elevation 4088.76 at the center line of Radcliffe Avenue; thence to elevation 4089.03 at the center line of South 6th Street; thence to elevation 4089.19 at the center line of East Main Street; thence to elevation 4089.09 at the center line of Martin Street; thence to elevation 4089.74 at the south city limits of Klamath Falls in Shasta Way

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 83, Oregon Laws 1931, and Chapter 629, Oregon Laws 1932; it is required that as a condition precedent to the change of the grade of any such street, or avenue, or road, such grade change shall be consented to by the City.

THEREFORE, the Commission HEREBY RESOLVED by the Commission of the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon, that the grade established by the State Highway Commission for the proposed improvement of the street or streets, or avenues, or roads, as described herein and which are altered by State Highway No. 20 of the State of Oregon, known as the Klamath Falls-Lakeview Highway, the plans for which proposed improvement are on file in the office of the State Highway Commission at Salem, Oregon, and a copy of copies of which are on file in the records of the City, said grades being as follows:
