

Road To Lake Will Be Fixed

... of the Woods summer owners, meeting with the city court yesterday, received assurance that the road from Rocky Point Junction, and the lower end of the lake to the Jackson county line, will be maintained in the same free as other county roads this summer.

He will become pastor of First Christian church at Oakland, Calif., and faculty member of the Pacific School of Religion at Berkeley.

Support Of Pepper Resolution Urged

WASHINGTON, March 28 (AP)—Scores of telegrams from Greek organizations and individuals in Oregon are being received by Senator Cordon urging him to support the resolution introduced by Senator Pepper (D-Ore.) asking that the Dodecanese islands be awarded to Greece.

The Greek orthodox community of Oregon cited the resistance of Greece to Germany and her aid to the allies during the war as one of the reasons she should be awarded the islands.

English Teacher Wanted For Prince

TOKYO, March 28 (AP)—Emperor Hirohito wants an American woman English teacher to crown Prince Akihito.

Dr. George Stoddard, New York state education commissioner and head of the U. S. education mission to Japan, was asked yesterday to find such an instructor to come to Japan.

Stoddard said he has no one in mind, but will receive a representative of the emperor tomorrow to discuss the request.

Smelt Start Run In Sandy River

PORTLAND, Ore., March 28 (AP)—Smelt began mounting the Sandy river today, and the city prepared to handle thousands of eager fishermen.

Fish Warden Arnie J. Suomela said the smelt apparently started the run about 6 this morning.

The fish, which migrate up the Sandy to spawn but fall to die some years, sometimes come so thickly they can be fished with a sieve or bare hands.

Bishop Says Catholic Church Threat To Religious Freedom

BOSTON, March 28 (AP)—Methodist Bishop G. Bromley Oxnam, president of the Federal Council of Churches of Christ in the United States, has accused the Roman Catholic church in America of constituting a "grave threat both to political and religious freedom."

Speaking last night at an ecumenical service in Trinity church in which ministers of all protestant denominations participated, Bishop Oxnam said that "pressures on newspapers, radio and other sources of public information, together with political activities... give protestants grave concern."

A spokesman for the Roman Catholic church in Boston declined comment on the protestant leader's assertions.

"When a protestant speaks of the abuse of privilege by the hierarchy, he is immediately portrayed as attacking the church," Bishop Oxnam said.

"This is not true. He stands ready to protect the religious liberty of the Roman Catholic church but he stands likewise ready to resist those practices that are political and designed to secure secular privilege."

"When Harold J. Laski (British laborite) was attacked because he criticized the Vatican's attitude toward Franco Spain, his efforts were made to keep his speech off the radio," the bishop asserted.

"Others who participated in the meeting were threatened," he said.

"It was left to Americans who are Roman Catholics to point out that the pope—who is a king as well as a head of a church—is subject to criticism for his political activities just as any ruler, and that such criticism is not an attack on the church."

"All we ask is that the Roman Catholic church in matters of religious liberty do unto others as it would be done by," Bishop Oxnam declared.

Man Convicted Of Robbing Mail Box

PORTLAND, March 28 (AP)—Robert Patrick Morgan, 25, Elmira, N. Y., was convicted in federal court yesterday of robbing a mail box in Grants Pass and escaping twice from the Multnomah county jail.

Morgan was arrested last August in Grants Pass. Brought here to await trial, he escaped from jail September 2, was recaptured, and broke out again September 24.
