RESOLUTION NO. 228

WHEREAS, State Highway No. 20, of the State of Oregon, known as the Klamath Falls-Lakeview Highway, is routed through the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon, municipal corporation, and the route officially adopted for said highway by the State Highway Commission, traverses the following street or streets, or avenues, or roads, or paths, or said city, to-wit:
