

# Communist Party In U. S. Serves Russia Directly

WASHINGTON, April 3 (AP)—Francis Budenz, former Communist Party editor, told house investigators today that "the Communist Party in the United States is a direct arm of the Soviet foreign department."

Budenz, who renounced Communism recently to join Notre Dame university's journalism department staff, also told the house committee investigating American activities that each American Communist is "a potential spy against the United States." Many of them are "unhappy" about this, he said.

He added that "any good relations" with Russia will be achieved only through "reaching the people of that nation, shut

in now behind walls of police censorship."

The hearing was closed to the public but Budenz left a statement for newsmen outlining what he told the committee. The statement continued:

**Direct Arm**

"The Communist Party in the United States is a direct arm of the Soviet foreign department. It serves a foreign power and never swerves from such service by a hair's breadth."

"What I further had to state was that the policy agreed upon and exemplified by the orders conveyed last year in the Jacques Duclos (a French Communist) letter was one of continuous hostility to the United States and injury to the American nation."

"It was a Hitlerite policy of world domination, to be established step by step through fifth columns."

"Whether that policy will be changed or not remains to be seen. There has been no indication of any such change; everything points to its continuance. That aim is the building up of Soviet power through the same domination of other countries that Hitler brought about, directed at the eventual destruction of the American nation."

# Homestead Meet Called

A meeting of vital interest to this community has been called by the U. S. bureau of reclamation for 1:30 p. m. Thursday at the Klamath County chamber of commerce.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss regulations and recommendations for an examination board for opening 87 homesteads in the Tulelake area. Names of persons to serve on this board will be suggested at this meeting and forwarded to the secretary of the interior, Washington, D. C., where appointment will be made from the names submitted.

Work of the board will include reviewing homestead applications from honorably discharged veterans of World War I and weeding out those which do not qualify.

The process of determining which 87 applicants will get the homesteads which will be available to veterans late this summer, will also be discussed. A tremendous number of applications is expected and a simple, efficient method of allotment, as well as a fair one must be worked out.

Representatives of farm organizations, the county agent's office and veterans organizations, including several selective service boards, have been invited to attend this meeting.

RALEIGH, N. C., April 3 (AP)—Thomas Dixon, 82, author of "The Clansman," upon which the great, silent motion picture, "The Birth of a Nation" was based, died at his home here early today after a long period of ill health.

Dixon, a native of Cleveland county in this state, began his career as a lawyer but he soon turned to the Baptist ministry. For 10 years he preached in New York City to ever growing congregations. His popularity as a pulpit orator brought him many demands to appear on the lecture platform.
