

Infection Of Potato ed Concern Of Growers

ection of potato seed is occupying the minds of growers now that plants are getting nearer. Potato is a disease which enters the soil and causes the potato to rot. These fungi are not cut potatoes, however, should be planted in less than two days after cutting. The layer of cork cells on the cut surface is best protection against seed piece rot. Dipping cut seed with Semesan Bel has some value in checking cutting knife spread of ring rot bacteria from ring rot infected tubers to healthy ones.

Land Prepared For Planting

Considerable farming, particularly plowing and planting of grain is now underway in the Klamath basin between spring showers. Quite a bit of land is being prepared for immediate planting of wheat and rye, some of which is already planted, also some peas have been planted but mainly for plowing under purposes for soil building. Some preparation of land for later planting of oats and barley is under way but some acreage is still too wet to be worked.

The running of potato seed and the cleaning out of potato cellars is also being done and in some cases potatoes are being prepared and treated for early planting. Generally first potatoes are planted about the last week or 10 days of April, but heavy planting does not get

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under way until after the first of May. Much building repair and some construction is underway and would be greatly increased if adequate materials were available. During the past two weeks quite a number of farmers have worked out their 1946 work plans and signed up the AAA program. The farm labor office has shown some increase in placements during March, but by the end of the month there was still a surplus of farm workers wanting work.

Spraying Aids Pest Control

Spraying for control of certain insect pest and plant disease in fruit trees can be done now, by using a dormant spray, according to Ernest Lindsay, assistant county agent.

The following pests or diseases can be sprayed now; San Jose scale, mite eggs, bilater mite, oyster shell scale, leaf roller, aphids and spider mites except red spider mites.

For controlling scab in apples and pears and brown rot in peaches the ground should be cultivated to turn under old leaves and to destroy spore cups on the ground.

The spray can be either lime, sulphur or oil spray, or the com-

bination of lime, sulphur, oil emulsion.

Commercial dormant oil emulsions are available in several forms. Any of these oils, properly used, will be effective as dormant sprays.

When dry lime sulphur is used for dormant spraying, it will take about five pounds of the dry powder to be equivalent

chemically to one gallon of the standard, concentrated liquid lime sulphur, testing about 32° by Baume hydrometer test.

GLAZED SPRING CARROTS
We like to serve these with broiled ham or spring lamb chops.
Scrub 18 to 20 small young carrots with a stiff brush. Cook in a small amount of boiling salted water until tender; drain. Melt 4 tablespoons butter or margarine and 2 tablespoons sugar in a frying pan. Add carrots and cook slowly, turning and basting frequently, about 10 minutes or until glazed and shiny in appearance. Serve hot. Serves 6.

WILTED SPINACH
An old favorite in many families is wilted lettuce; here's something similar, using early spring spinach.
Wash young tender spinach well; tear leaves into small pieces. Place in a hot serving dish or salad bowl. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and let stand a few minutes to wilt slightly. Heat together 2 or 3 tablespoons bacon drippings, ¼ cup vinegar, and a dash of mustard and sugar. When mixture begins to boil, pour over spinach and toss lightly to mix. Garnish with chopped green onion, hard-cooked egg slices and radishes. Serve at once. Serves 6.

RHUBARB UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE
Most families go for upside-down cake, but they'll consider it a special treat when it's made with rhubarb.
Arrange 3 cups diced rhubarb in a well-greased 8"x8"x2" cake pan. Sprinkle with 1½ cups sugar combined with 2 tablespoons corn starch. (I like to use half brown sugar and half granulated.) Mix up your favorite plain or sponge cake recipe and pour over rhubarb. Bake in moderate (350° F.) oven 30 to 40 minutes or until done. Invert on rack to cool. To serve, cut in squares and top with whipped cream.
