# Young Dischargee Enlists in Navy

# Hood River Power Line Will Be Built

HOOD RIVER, Ore., April 8 (AP)—Construction of the first section of power line planned by the Hood River Electric Cooperative to serve the valley will begin this week, Manager Courtland Morchouse reported today.

The first section will be a five-mile line sending Bonneville power to Odell made from materials salvaged from the electric system of Hanford, Wash., atomic bomb city.

The cooperative recently purchased the system for \$101,000, and Morchouse said today about 75 per cent of it has been dismantled.

# Klamath Men Fly 2 Planes Back Here From East Coast

The five Klamath Falls men who drove to the east coast to bring two Ecoupeas back, returned last week.

Harold Irwin, who drove the car back, returned before the others. Cy Wallen, Clem Thompson, M. J. "Bus" Thompson and Greg Duran flew the planes back, taking seven days. Flight time was 31 hours but they made frequent landings and were grounded twice on account of weather.

They landed at Knoxville and Memphis, Tenn., Pine Bluffs, Ark., where they stopped over, Phoenix and Tucson, Ariz., Dallas, Midland, where they made another stop-over and El Paso, Tex., Tulsa and Madera, Calif. Pine Bluffs and Midland stops were made on account of bad weather and they stopped in Madera to visit Mr. and Mrs. Les Thompson, relatives of the "Bus" Thompsons.

On one stretch, storms and rain were encountered but the men refused to turn back and soon flew through the bad weather into clear skies. Weather ahead was reported rough over the Guadalupe pass in Texas, but the flyers had no trouble there.

At one point on the flight over Texas, smoke from a burning oil well looked to the men above like a cyclone. They circled the funnel of smoke preparing to make an emergency landing. Bumpy rough air was encountered over the pass near Palm Springs, but not once during the entire flight did the two planes get off the course.
