Men Needed In Air Depots

Workers are needed in Uncle Sam's overseas air depots, and excellent opportunities are available in a variety of positions relative to air corps and general aircraft supply and maintenance. Complete details are available in the local United States employment service office, according to the war department recruiter now in this state.

Assignments are being made to the Hawaiian islands and the Panama Canal zone air depots. In the ungraded positions, salaries range up to \$1.54 an hour, while the graded positions of clerk, stenographer and typist pay up to \$2130 a year. All employment is for 18 months with the exception of Panama where the term of service is one year.

Mail Communication With Germany Open

Mail communication with Germany, shut down since November 1, 1939, was reopened April 1, by an order of Gael Sullivan, acting postmaster general.

Effecting immediately, letters weighing not more than one ounce and non illustrated post cards will be accepted for transmission to Germany at all U. S. post offices. For the present, communications are restricted to those of a personal or family character. No communications of a financial, commercial or business character may be sent. Enclosures of checks, drafts, securities or currency are prohibited.

Air mail, registration, special delivery, money order and parcel post services are not yet available. Other information regarding mail to Germany may be obtained from Burt E. Hawkins, Klamath Falls postmaster.
