

Egg Supply Will Meet Easter Demand

SAN FRANCISCO, April 19 (AP)—The Pacific coast states have a huge supply of eggs to meet a big Easter demand.

Production figures last week for the first time passed last year's mark. Although the hens are producing fewer eggs than in the record year of 1944, civilians have more because of reductions in exports and military purchases.

Lively egg sales were reported from Seattle to Los Angeles, with a large demand for fancy grades. Eggs stocks are at an unprecedented level.
