

CAB Sees Decision Soon In Coast Airlines Case

WASHINGTON, April 23 (AP) Officials of the civil aeronautics board predicted today a decision will be announced "very soon" in the West Coast Airlines case, providing service for western communities now without plane service.

Following lengthy hearings, two examiners made recommendations to the civil aeronautics board last fall, outlining "feeder" services for passengers

tributary to the major routes, and proposing a "pick up and delivery" service for mail and express at many small towns.

Another hearing was held April 9 on an application by United Air Lines, Inc., to consolidate its transcontinental route 11 and its Pacific coast route No. 1.

Permission for the consolidation would be followed by an application for non-stop flights between points on these routes. The situation is being watched closely by officials of Nevada Airlines, Inc., hopeful of developing a system extending from Reno into neighboring states.

Serve Klamath Falls

Nevada's president, Thomas O. Craven, recently asked Rep. Bunker (D-Nev.) whether the proposed UAL consolidation would adversely affect plans of his line to serve Klamath Falls and Medford, Ore., and several Nevada and California towns between Reno and Los Angeles.

The application of Nevada Airlines to serve many of these points failed to receive approval of examiners in the west coast case but the possibility of more favorable action by the board is regarded hopefully by the line's officials.

A UAL traffic official, Harold Grady, has testified that "if these routes (1 and 11) were consolidated, we could operate service from Seattle and Tacoma to Reno and down the east side of the (Sierra Nevada) mountains to Los Angeles." The line operates now on the west side of the mountains.

Grady also suggested the possibility, if the routes were consolidated, of routing an eastward non-stop flight from Portland, Ore., through Salem and Eugene and directly eastward from Medford.

Birds Return To Lava Beds Monument

Birds are returning and flowers are blooming in Lava Beds national monument, according to Don Fisher, custodian, who states that travel to the monument at present equals prewar travel figures, which reached 36,000 per year.

John Offel of the Lava Beds plans to attend the regional fire school to be held in Port Angeles from May 6 to 10. Chief Ranger Carlisle Crouch of Crater Lake national park will be one of the principal speakers.
