

Growers To Talk Starch Plant Plans

A general meeting of potato growers has been set for 8 p. m. Friday at the Merrill community hall. Northwest Chemurgy Cooperative representatives will be present to answer growers' questions.

Klamath basin bankers met Tuesday at Merrill with starch plant committee members of Tulelake Growers and Klamath Potato Growers associations. This morning's meeting was attended by Northwest Chemurgy Cooperative representative, Ronald Smith.

A completely outfitted starch factory is available for purchase in Mississippi, according to Smith. The plant built with federal funds was to have processed sweet potatoes which were to have been grown on logged off stump land in that area.

Machinery needed in the proposed Klamath basin plant is difficult to purchase through normal channels, Smith said. Strikes in steel, coal and motor manufacturing companies has resulted in shortages. Heavy demand has booked motor orders for the next year's production.

The Mississippi plant would furnish practically all machinery necessary in the project planned for Klamath. Northwest Chemurgy Cooperative has a limited option on the Mississippi plant but no need for the machinery except as it is to be used in the Klamath basin.

The Chemurgy directors want assurance by Saturday, April 27 that Klamath Basin Growers will support construction of a plant here so that the Mississippi plant option may be taken up.

Escrow instructions now being used here in fund gathering efforts provide for refund of money to growers if \$100,000 is not gathered by June 1.

The availability of the Mississippi plant machinery leads to intensive fund gathering efforts this week. Committee members feel that a large percentage of the necessary capital can be subscribed by Saturday, April 27.

CWO Robert Wilson Will Leave Klamath
