

Soil Erosion Causes Shown

Reasons for soil erosion and way of preventing it were shown in a film "Under Western Skies," sponsored by J. W. Kerns Implement company, to a group of growers last night in the American Legion hall.

H. W. Berry, assistant branch manager and R. W. Grant, territory representative of the International Harvester company, Portland, explained the films, made through the cooperation of the state colleges of Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Nevada and California and soil conservation field men in those states.

Land leveling, planting across slopes, using flumes for irrigation water where earth is soft and washes easily, trees planted along hilltops to break the wind that carries away soil, and leaving stubble in fields, were some of the methods shown in the color film to prevent soil erosion.

Another film showing the latest developments in farm machinery and a short reel of water sports were also shown.

2 War Vets Scale Peak

Recently they climbed Maiden peak, hiking as far as Rosary lake the first day and slept out in the open, although there are several feet of snow on the ground. They reported there were also 8 inches of ice on the lake. The next day they scaled Maiden peak. The snow has drifted greatly on Maiden peak, showing the winds have been of high velocity during the winter months. The one shutter was broken in the lookout at the peak and the place was full of snow.

On top of the mountain they were able to get a good view of the surrounding territory and they reported that Waldo lake is entirely frozen over with not a vestige of water on the entire lake.

While in the army Kearney spent a furlough in the Austrian Alps skiing. They went to Portland for Easter to spend their first Easter in three years with their families but expect to return to Odell lake.

Bids on the project were opened April 5. The project involves furnishing and placing 3150 feet of conduit, 14 twin light standards, 8 single light standards, 14 twin light transformers, 8 single transformers, and 36 luminaires.

2 Former KF Men In News

Two former Klamath men were featured in the news this week when Roy L. Orem of Portland, vice president of the United States National corporation, became the guest of his brother, Capt. Howard E. Orem, commanding the light cruiser Houston en route to Gibraltar to become the flagship of Adm. H. K. Hewitt, commander of United States naval forces in European waters.

The Houston is scheduled to relieve the heavy cruiser Helena at a ceremony to take place at Gibraltar about May 2. Adm. Hewitt will arrive at Gibraltar aboard the famous Missouri on April 30. Capt. Orem will transfer from the Houston to the Missouri at Gibraltar for the return cruise to the United States.

Capt. Orem, a graduate of the naval academy to which he was appointed following his graduation from the old Klamath County high school in 1918, took command of the Houston last July after serving for nearly two years as aide and flag secretary to Admiral of the Fleet Ernest J. King. Prior to the tour of duty at Washington he served with a cruiser division at Guadalcanal and Rennell islands and in the Aleutians. The cruiser Houston is the second ship to bear that name in this war. The first Houston was lost in action in 1942 off Java.

Both Roy and Howard E. Orem are brothers of Mrs. J. I. Beard of this city.

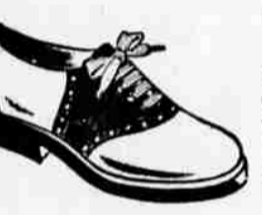

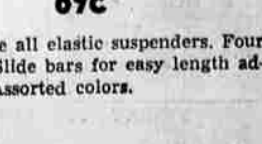
