WHEAT—CHICAGO, April 23 (AP)—Oats and rye firmed toward the close today following announcement by the agriculture department that the 30,000,000 bushel of corn it hopes to purchase under the bonds payment plan will be used for feed. The corn will go for export and to processors, the department said. The late capture saved losses which at one time had extended to as much as 5 cents in May 23.

There were a few sales in July and December wheat at ceilings, the first transactions in some time. All wheat, corn, barley and deferred rye contracts closed at ceilings. Oats closed unchanged in 1/2¢ higher. July 30c and May rye was 1 1/2¢ lower at \$2.61 1/2-2.61 on a burst of selling at the close.
